BACHELOR'S PROGRAMME CZECH STUDIES FOR FOREIGNERS

- **form of study:** full-time Bachelor's
- **combinations:** single-subject; cannot be combined with another field of study

The study programme is intended for

- international students and foreigners living in the Czech Republic;
- graduates from Czech or foreign tertiary schools in any field (humanities or natural sciences) who want to learn more about Czech language and culture in the *Czech Studies for Foreigners* Bachelor's programme to be able to live in the Czech cultural environment or to keep in contact with Czech companies and state institutions;
- for future diplomats as an extension of their studies of Czech language and culture.

MASTER'S PROGRAMME CZECH STUDIES FOR FOREIGNERS

- **form of study:** full-time Master's
- **combinations:** single-subject; cannot be combined with another field of study

The study programme is intended for

- Those who want to be able to utilise written and spoken Czech in all standard and professional communication situations at a level corresponding to at least the minimum required for C1 in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages.

Potential careers

- professional (language editor, teacher of Czech at secondary and tertiary schools abroad, translator etc.);
- the media;
- cultural institutions;
- diplomatic services etc.;
- research (doctoral studies).

The study programme provides a solid foundation of specialised education that is universal enough to serve as a starting point for other fields in philology, the art sciences and culturology.



COURSES OF CZECH LANGUAGE AND CULTURE FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS AT THE FACULTY OF ARTS

The course is designed for international students, post-graduates and visiting professors.

The programme includes

- courses of Czech language at the corresponding language level;
- additional lectures and seminars on Czech culture, literature and history.
