will take place on the 10th and 11th of November 2022 at the Faculty of Arts of Palacký University in Olomouc.

Since the 1990s we can observe rising numbers of foreigners who learn Czech as a second language. Concurrently, there is an increasing need to define and delimitate the teaching of non-native speakers of Czech and to describe Czech linguistically and didactically. The aim of the conference is to create a platform for sharing expertise and practical experiences in teaching Czech as a foreign/second language and its acquisition. Contributions from the conference will be published in the peer-reviewed journal Bohemica Olomucensia.

We welcome contributions that discuss the following topics:

- 1) grammatical descriptions of Czech for the use in teaching non-native speakers;
- 2) application of methodical approaches for the development of communication skills;
- 3) building of sociocultural competences;
- 4) the problems of learning Czech in relation to the mother tongue;
- 5) the teaching of Czech as a foreign/second language in the Czech Republic and abroad;
- 6) Czech as a mother tongue and second language in teaching practice.

The official languages of the conference will be Czech and English.
